



RED ROSE AWARD

The Red Rose Award is a recognition program designed to increase the visibility of Delta Kappa Gamma in local chapter areas and to focus on promoting the work of women leaders in education--those whose careers are education as well as women in other fields who advance the cause of education.

The program was established in 1997-1998 to promote and recognize participation and achievement of women in visible leadership roles.

GUIDELINES FOR NOMINATION

1. The recipient of the Red Rose Award must be a non-member of the Society.
2. She shall be a woman leader who resides and/or works in Meridian or Lauderdale County.
3. Her accomplishments should have benefitted education and the status of women in educational leadership roles.

PROCEDURE FOR NOMINATION

The attached recommendation form should be submitted to the chairman of Gamma Chapter's Personal Growth and Services Committee no later than October 15th.
